### **OnTime Networks (OTN) statement related conflicting minerals - 3TG**

OTN supports the efforts to eliminate trade of “Conflict Minerals” – 3TG, from the Democratic Republic of Congo.

OTN can provide a Conflict Minerals Reporting Template (CMRT) that are based on collecting CMRT as well as 3TG statements from the OTN suppliers.

Electronics parts used in OTN designs do only to a small extent contain tungsten, while some capacitor used are of tantalum electrolytic capacitor type, and these parts do contain tantalum. Gold is also used extensively in IC and board-to-board connectors used in the OTN designs. Parts containing tin, tantalum and gold are sourced from suppliers, where each supplier can provide statement published on their web page, stating the following:

- their parts do not use Conflict Minerals in the material they source to us.
- they maintain a policy against sourcing any material from DRC.

Full CMRT declaration for each component containing tungsten, tin, tantalum and gold are requested from the main OTN suppliers, while 3TG statements are collected from each OTN supplier.
